

Cong list: Leaders quit, vow to defeat Revanth

Party workers resort to violence in some places

All hell broke loose, literally, within the Congress soon after the party released its first list of 55 candidates on Sunday, with party workers resorting to violence in some places, while a few leaders, who failed to get tickets, quit the party.

RELEASES FIRST LIST OF 55 CANDIDATES

HYDERABAD: The Congress released the first list of 55 candidates for the forthcoming Assembly elections in Telangana. The list, which throws to the wind the party's proclaimed stands — including the Udaipur Declaration, which stipulates only one seat per family - includes Mynampally Hanumantha Rao and his son Mynampally Rohit. The two, whose entry into the Congress saw a number of senior leaders quitting the party, will contest from Malkajgiri and Medak. (REPORT PAGE 6)

I-T seizes over Rs 50 cr in K'taka

BENGALURU

Income Tax sleuths have recovered more than Rs 50 crore cash during raids on several people including a contractor, his son, a gymnasium instructor and an architect in Karnataka, a highly-placed department official said on Sunday.

The raids that started on Thursday at 25 places belonging to two major infrastructure companies expanded to 45 by Saturday evening, the official said, requesting anonymity. Charging them with tax evasion, the I-T officials raided their offices at various places. Several documents were confiscated. Followed by the lead obtained from these two firms, I-T officials searched the houses and other places of contractors and various

other people.
"A total of 45 locations were searched till Friday while ten more places were raided and searched on Saturday. On Saturday, the third day of the operation. an architect and a gymnasium owner's house was raided from where Rs 8 crore in cash was seized. With this, the total amount of cash seized has crossed Rs 50 crore," the official said. The raids are still on, he added. According to sources in the BJP, the contractor whose house was raided was the most prominent face of the allegations of 40 per cent commission against the previous BJP government. PTI
