# Poverty rate drops in State

#### Down from 13.18% in 2015-16 to 3.76% in 22-23

Telangana has emerged as a frontrunner in the multidimensional poverty index (MPI), witnessing a steep decline from 13.18 per cent in 2015-16 to 3.76 per cent in 2022-23. In Telangana, over 17.67 lakh of the nearly 4.7 crore population are esti-mated to be multidimen-

sionally poor. During the corresponding period, India recorded an estimated absolute change in the headcount ratio of 17.89 percentage points, which is equivalent to approximately 24.82 crore individuals escaping multidi-2022-23. As per the trend, India is much ahead of the target of reducing poverty in all its dimensions by half, by the year 2030.

HYDERABAD: Telangana has retained its top performer status at the States' Startup Rankings for the year 2022. Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade under Union Ministry of Commerce and Industry appreciated the State for developing a strong startup ecosystem. The States' Startup Ranking for 2022 was released by Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal here on Tuesday.

## Hyd firm plans flying taxis in India

ome 2025, beat the unruly traffic congestion in cities by taking off in an air taxi. Hyderabad-based

The flying taxis will be operated using electric Vertical Take-off and Landing (eVTOL) aircraft, commonly referred to as air taxis or flying taxis. These battery-pow-

field of eVTOL aircraft. The SkyDrive has already succeeded in the first crewed eVTOL flight test in Japan in 2019 and its eVTOL 'SkyDrive' is in the process of acquiring its Japan Civil Aviation Bureau certification.
