# **CBI to probe NEET-UG** case, NTA chief out

### NEET-PG exam postponed; panel to review exams and NTA

The Centre on Saturday night announced that the probe into the alleged irregularities in the medical entrance exam NEET will be handed over to the CBI for a comprehensive probe.

The development came amid a flurry of decisions over alleged irregularities in competitive exams, including the removal of National Testing Agency (NTA) Director General Subodh Singh and setting up of a seven-member panel headed by former ISRO chief K Radhakrishnan for exam reforms.

"Certain cases of alleged irregularities, cheating, impersonation and malpractices have been reported in NEET-UG, which was conducted on May 5. For transparency on the conduct of the examination process, it was decided after a review that the matter be handed over to the Central Bureau of Investigation for comprehensive investigation," a senior Education Ministry official said. #### Anti-paper leak law comes into force amid NEET row

NEW DELHI: The Centre has operationalised a stringent law that aims to curb malpractices and irregularities in competitive examinations and entails provisions for a maximum jail term of 10 years and a fine of up to Rs 1 crore for offenders. Nearly four months after President Droupadi Murmu gave assent to The Public Examinations (Prevention of Unfair Means) Act, 2024, the Personnel Ministry on Friday night issued a notification, saying the provisions of the law will come into force from June 21. The Act aims to prevent unfair means in the public examinations conducted by the UPSC, Railways and others. PTI

**GST** Council tweaks tax rates of items

#### NEW DELHI

The GST Council on Saturday decided to tweak tax rates on items, including accommodation for students and solar cookers, and took a host of taxpayer-friendly measures.

Briefing reporters after the 53rd GST Council meeting, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman said the Council has recommended to roll out the biometric-based Aadhaar authentication of registration applicants on a pan-India basis in a phased manner. This will help check fraudulent registration done to avail input tax credit and evade taxes.

To reduce litigation, it decided to fix a monetary limit for tax officers to file appeals before the GST Appellate Tribunal, the High Court and the Supreme Court at Rs 20 lakh, Rs 1 crore and Rs 2 crore, respectively.

Services provided by Railways — platform tickets, retiring rooms/waiting rooms, cloak rooms, battery-operated cars and intra-railway transactions — would be exempt from GST. Additionally, Sitharaman said the intention of the Centre has been to bring petrol and diesel under GST, and it is up to the States to decide on the rate. The next meeting of the Council is in August. PTI

# weaver dies by suicide Burdened by debts & no work,

# Nagaraju consumes acid

Even as the Congress-led State government remains silent on the annual order of Bathukamma sarees worth Rs 350 crore to weavers, one more weaver died by suicide after he came under immense financial stress due to lack of work.

The last six months have seen at least 11 weavers taking their lives after going out of work since the current government stopped giving orders that were an annual practice during the BRS regime.

Most of the suicide deaths have been after weavers, sitting idle without work for six months, became unable to run their families, to clear off debts and afford healthcare expenses.

The latest was the death of Kudikyala Nagaraju (47) of Sircilla, who consumed acid and ended his life on Friday. He took the extreme step when his family mem-
