### Mob loots AK-47s from Manipur PS

IMPHAL A mob stormed a police station in Manipur's Ukhrul town and looted arms during a clash be-

tween two groups, officials said on Thursday. Three persons were killed and 20 others injured in a gunfight that broke out between two groups on Wednesday over cleaning a disputed land in the town as part of 'Swachhata Abhiyan'. The police station was attacked when the violence was going on.

Prohibitory orders were imposed and mobile internet services were suspended in the town after the clash between two groups of the Naga community. "After violence broke out in Ukhrul town, a mob comprising mostly of youths stormed the police station located at Wino Bazar and de-camped with government weapons," an official said.

The number and types of weapons looted cannot be immediately confirmed as an investigation is continuing, he added. But sources claimed that the looted weapons included AK-47 and INSAS rifles. Looting of arms was reported from various police stations in the ethnicstrife-torn State earlier, but in all those cases the areas were dominated by either Meities or Kukis. PTI


### Minister retracts remarks on Sam but raises divorce issue again

# Israeli strike kills nine in Beirut

### BEIRUT

An Israeli airstrike on an apartment in central Beirut has killed nine people, according to Lebanon's Health Ministry. There was no warning before the strik late on Wednesday, which hit an apartment in central Beirut not far from the United Nations headquarters, the Prime Minister's office and parliament. Hezbollah's civil defence unit said seven of its members were killed. The strike came as Israel was pursuing a ground incursion into Lebanon against Hezbollah, while also conducting strikes in Gaza that killed dozens, including children. Meanwhile, the Lebanese Red Cross said an Israeli strike killed four of its paramedics and a Lebanese army soldier as they were evacuating wounded people from the south. It said the convoy near the village of Taybeh, which was accompanied by Lebanese troops, was targeted on Thursday despite coordinating its movements with UN peacekeepers. The Israeli military has ordered the evacuation of villages and towns in south-

The Congress-led State government has been on an unprecedented borrowing spree. Since coming to power in December last year, it has borrowed an average of Rs 241 crore per

day in the last 300-odd days. Currently, the State debt

stands at around Rs 72,500 crore since the Congress came to power, while the market borrowings are at around Rs 32,500 crore in the first two quarters of the current fiscal year.

The borrowings began with a Rs 500-crore loan on December 12, 2023, and has continued at an alarming rate, with loans averaging

Rs 5,000 crore per month. As of September 30, Rs 47,618 crore of the debt was directly sourced from the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) through market borrowings. During the last month alone, the State government secured Rs 2,500 crore on September 3, Rs 1,500 crore

on September 10, Rs 500 crore on September 17 and another Rs 1,000 crore in the last week of September. The State government is likely to raise another Rs 7,400 crore through market borrowings in the third quarter (October to December) of 2024-25. (SEE PAGE 2)

### Azhar skips ED summons in PMLA case

#### CITY BUREAU Hyderabad

Former Indian cricket captain and Congress leader Mohammad Azharuddin on Thursday failed to appear before the ED in a money laundering case linked to al-

leged financial irregularities in the Hyderabad Cricket Association (HCA). The former Member of Parliament, who is currently

the working president of the Telangana Pradesh Congress Committee (TPCC), was asked to appear before the ED on Thursday. However, it was learned that he did not appear before the central law enforcing agency and is said to have sought more time.

The ED, which is probing the Rs 20crore fraud case in the HCA, had questioned former cricketers Arshad Avub and Shivlal Yadav in December last year. For-

mer Minister and former HCA president G Vinod was also questioned

In November last year, the ED carried out searches at the residences of Vinod, Shivlal Yadav and Arshad Ayub. The searches were conducted at nine locations across the State under provisions of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA). The ED's investigation was based on three



by the Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB), Hyderabad, relating to criminal misappropriation of HCA funds to the tune of Rs 20 crore.

The ACB had registered FIRs for alleged irregularities in the procurement of by the central agency.

NEW DELHI: The BJP on Thursday flayed the Congress over Karnataka Minister Dinesh Gundu Rao's controversial remarks about VD Savarkar, saying the revolutionary freedom fighter is insulted by the party whose leaders never ever faced imprisonment at cellular jail in Andaman-Nicobar Islands by the British. "The party whose none of the leaders ever suffered 'kala pani ki saja' even for one day is insulting the person who was handed down double life imprisonment at cellular jail in Andaman-Nicobar Islands," BJP national general secretary Tarun Chugh said.
